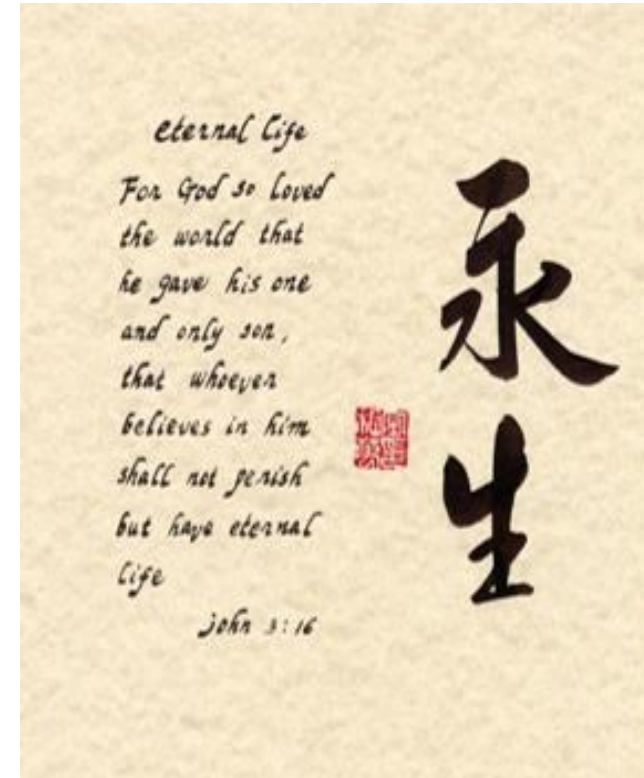

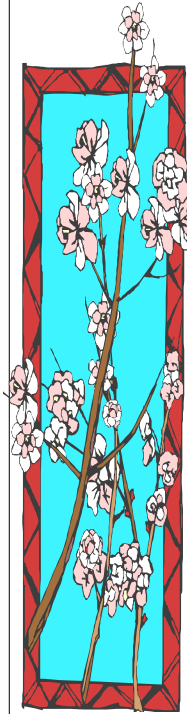
RENEWED HOPE CHILDRENS HOME EDUCATION SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM

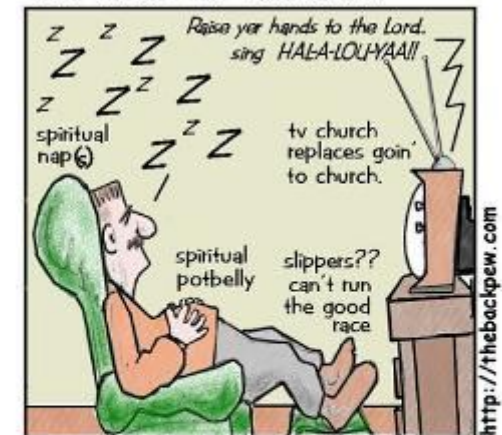
